# War hero tells story

The Vietnam War column continues...



Marble Mountain Air Facility also known as Da Nang, controlled by United States Marine Corps from 1965-71 and was in use August 1965 to March 1975.

Da Nang Air Base was used as the primary entry point for all American Service Members flying into Vietnam as well as an important sea port. Da Nang was the largest air base north of Saigon. The N.V.A. (North Vietnamese Army) offense launch during TET could hardly ignore it.

After the attack Marine leaders in DA Nang sought re-enforcement from the Army, who coordinated offensive action with the Marines. The engagement was fierce, costly and ultimately successful.



On January 30, 1965, a 15-man commando squad penetrated Da Nang Air Base and blew up bravo combat operations centers. From that time on, the fighting in and around Da Nang was very tight and difficult. This fighting the TET Offense at Da Nang lasted until (approximately) the morning of February 1 when started attempting to take Hue.



On April 22, 1965 the first helicopter assault landing of Marines in Republic of Vietnam. It was the first extended clash with the enemy in a valley near Da Nang.

#### Hawaiian Tortellini Salad



1 16-oz. bag frozen cheese tortellini (cook 2-3 minutes) 1 large orange bell pepper (diced) 1 English cucumber (diced)  $\frac{1}{2}$  medium red onion (diced) 16 oz. cherry tomatoes (diced or cut in half) 1 14-oz. can pineapple tidbits (drained & reserve 1/2 juice)

2 cups ham (optional)

Mix all of the vegetables together in a large bowl.

#### Dressing:

- 1/2 cup mayonnaise
- $\frac{1}{2}$  cup sour cream
- $\frac{1}{2}$  cup pineapple juice (that was reserved)
- 1 Tablespoon sugar
- 1 Tablespoon Dijon mustard
- 1 teaspoon fresh ginger OR 1/4 teaspoon ground ginger
- 1 teaspoon black pepper

Mix well. Add <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> of the dressing to the bowl of vegetables. Before serving, add the remainder of the dressing.
