Tortilla Soup

- 1 large chopped onion
- 1 tsp. chopped garlic (or more if you wish)
- 1 cup chopped celery
- 1 cup chopped carrots

Cook in 32 oz. chicken broth for 15 to 20 minutes.

- 1 can (14.5 oz.) diced tomatoes with jalapeno
- 1/2 cup salsa
- 1 Tbsp. dry taco seasoning
- Salt and pepper to taste
- 2 cups cooked shredded chicken (about 2 breasts)
- 1 can corn
- 1 can Negro beans rinsed and drained
- 1 Tbsp. lime juice (optional)

Simmer.

Optional Toppings: tortilla chips, fresh cilantro, shredded cheese, chopped avocado. (I have used turkey instead of chicken many times).




